Craftsmanship



The bar is done in a serpentine shape, with the wood front, the concrete counter, and the footrail all matching the curves.

The bar back is tiled in blue glass, with the shelves cut out and recessed into the wall, giving it the appearance of one solid piece.



There are seven of the bottle display columns in the restaurant, filled with over 1,400 glass bottles. Some of the columns are whole, and some are half and set into the wall.

The benches along the walls are fabric covered, and have a tapered top, along with an ergonomic curve to the back. The smaller, freestanding benches were also custom built.

Giffin also supplied the frames that are hung from the ceiling, filled with show artwork, and serve as room dividers.
