## Craftsmanship



The large radius of this cherry and solid surface desk created challenges easily overcome by Giffin's experienced craftsmen.



Throughout the project, Giffin's cherry and fabric panels adorn the custom casework, as shown on this reception desk at the entrance to the building.



When the borough decided to replicate the historic Carnegie railroad watchtower for use as a podium, Giffin was chosen for their expertise in fabricating unique and distinctive pieces. This podium was created based only on the artist's rendition shown far left. It serves as a symbol of Carnegie's industrial heritage, while also acting as a place for citizens to address their council, complete with microphone and lighting.
